Reading 2.

Recycling plastics is easy. First, you should learn what types of plastics can be recycled and give your collector those types of plastics. Plastics have different formulations and should be sorted before they are recycled to make new products. Mixed plastics can be recycled, but they are not as valuable as sorted plastics.

Once you know what kinds of plastics your recycler want, you should follow the wash and squash rule – the container should be rinsed and squashed. The paper labels may be left on the container, but the plastics caps should be thrown away. Plastics caps are usually made from a different type of plastic than the container and cannot be easily recycled.


